New School & Child care Immunization Rate Reporting Process

Per Nevada Revised Statutes (NRS) 392.435, 394.192, 432A.230 and 432A.235, every year by December 31st, schools, child care and accommodation facilities must submit immunization rates to the Division of Public and Behavioral Health. In the past, the Nevada State Immunization Program (NSIP) has collected data based on immunization percentages schools, child care and accommodation facilities calculate and provide. As of 2019, rate reporting questions will align with the annual Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) School Assessment, providing more detailed immunization data.

Resources

NSIP staff will provide resources to complete the surveys, including an Annual School Immunization Reporting Instruction Packet and Immunization Tally Sheets, on https://www.vfcnevada.org/. To assist with data submission, the instruction packet is organized by grade level and includes additional resources such as related definitions.

The Future of Nevada

The new process will provide NSIP with school and county level data which can be disseminated to school and child care facility staff, so they are better informed should they need to coordinate a vaccine preventable disease outbreak response.

It's Here! Are You Ready?

The Nevada State Immunization Program (NSIP) has exciting news. The new immunization rate reporting system is launching November 25, 2019!

This will be the first year schools will only have to submit immunization rates one time. In the past, NSIP collected 30 de-identified student records from select schools to be reviewed for the annual CDC School Assessment. This year, the immunization data submitted on https://www.vfcnevada.org/will also fulfill the CDC School Assessment reporting requirement.
