



# VACCINES FOR NEVADA PRE-K AND KINDERGARTEN

**IF YOUR CHILD IS HEADING TO KINDERGARTEN THIS FALL**, it's time to think about school vaccines. Now is the time to establish a primary care provider and schedule an appointment to get up to date on school vaccinations.

Required & Recommended Vaccines for Kindergarten:			
<b>DTP, DT, DTaP*</b> (4 or 5 doses)	<b>MMR*</b> (2 doses)	<b>Varicella*</b> (2 doses)	<b>Flu</b> (Annually)
<b>Polio*</b> (IPV - 3 or 4 doses)	<b>Hepatitis A*</b> (2 doses)	<b>Hepatitis B*</b> (3 doses)	

**NEVADA LAW REQUIRES CERTAIN IMMUNIZATIONS** (those marked \*) for public school entry – unless exempt due to a medical condition or religious belief. Other listed vaccines are recommended for elementary school students to help ensure good health.

**WORRIED ABOUT PAYING FOR VACCINES?** Many Nevada healthcare providers offer vaccines at low or no cost to parents as part of the Vaccines for Children (VFC) program (Younger than 19 years of age).
