

VACCINES FOR NEVADA PRE-KAND KINDERGARTEN

IF YOUR CHILD IS HEADING TO KINDERGARTEN THIS FALL, it's time to think about school vaccines. Now is the time to establish a primary care provider and schedule an appointment to get up to date on school vaccinations.

NEVADA LAW REQUIRES CERTAIN IMMUNIZATIONS (those marked *) for public school entry – unless exempt due to a medical condition or religious belief. Other listed vaccines are recommended for elementary school students to help ensure good health.

WORRIED ABOUT PAYING FOR VACCINES? Many Nevada healthcare providers offer vaccines at low or no cost to parents as part of the Vaccines for Children (VFC) program (Younger than 19 years of age). To find a provider near you, visit immunizenevada.org/paying-vaccines.
